Domaine Billaud-Simon Chablis	Code:C1023212	12-bottles	£115
Bernard Billaud crafts some of the finest wines in the region, renowned for their nery tension and distinct purity. The 2012 Chablis is no exception and displays beautiful ripe fruit with characteristic mineral nuances.			
Domaine Billaud-Simon Chablis 1er Cru Montée de Tonnerre	Code:B0955812	6-bottles	£105
Montée de Tonnerre is one of Chablis’ greatest premier crus and this often displays an almost Grand Cru-like intensity. It’s still quite restrained but shows remarkable concentration with fine minerality and an expansive, long finish.			
Domaine des Malandes Chablis 1er Cru Vau de Vey	Code:C1063512	12-bottles	£130
“The reticent nose of green fruit, Granny Smith apples, spice and oyster shells gives way to driving, delineated and intensely mineral-infused medium-bodied flavours that terminate in a moderately austere finish of very good persistence.” (89-91) Allen Meadows, Burghound, Oct 2013

DOMAINE JEAN CHARTRON

Domaine Jean Chartron was founded by Jean-Edouard Dupard in 1859. As mayor of Puligny, Jean-Edouard was instrumental in adding ‘Montrachet’ - the most prestigious local vineyard name - to the village name of Puligny.

Averys has worked with the Chartron family for many years and used to buy from the firm, Chartron et Trebuchet. A chance meeting with Jean-Michel, Jean Edouard’s great, great grandson, in a restaurant whilst tasting the 2009s put us back in touch. We have since offered the 2010s and 2011s en primeur which have proved to be immensely popular additions to the list. The 2012s showed extremely well on our en primeur buying trip in November and were among the best of the whites we tasted all week.

Domaine Jean Chartron Hautes Côtes de Beaune Blanc en Bois Guillemain	Code:C1595112	12-bottles	£135
A fresh, bright nose with an attractive creamy mid palate balanced by a lovely lick of tangy citrus acidity on the finish.			
Domaine Jean Chartron St Aubin 1er Cru Murgers des Dents de Chiens	Code:C1595212	12-bottles	£275
St Aubin is very close to Puligny Montrachet and the structure of the soil is largely the same. It’s a village Chartron has invested in heavily as he believes it is one of the top white Burgundy villages and offers excellent value. A very appealing nose with an abundance of citrus and peach fruit alongside hints of cherry blossom. Very energetic with a high mineral focus.			
Domaine Jean Chartron Chassagne Montrachet Benoités	Code:C1902212	12-bottles	£340
Fragrant and ripe open fruit on the nose with hints of freshly baked bread; the rich fruit develops on the palate with savoury background notes. The finish is very long with lovely lemony freshness.			
Domaine Jean Chartron Puligny Montrachet	Code:C1432812	12-bottles	£350
There’s not an ounce of fat on this wonderfully sleek, glassy Chardonnay with a tingly fresh nose of lime zest. It’s crisp and lively on the palate with impressive purity of fruit.			
Domaine Jean Chartron Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru les Folatieres	Code:B1058812	6-bottles	£265
This is much richer than the village wine in style with a really intense nose of yellow fruit with smoky nuances. There’s plenty of weight and intensity on the palate too with background toast and spicy complexity.			
Domaine Jean Chartron Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru Clos de la Pucelle	Code:B1433012	6-bottles	£295
An overt nose with sweet toasty oak and spices balanced by rich, fresh fruits. A concentrated core with a silky, fine texture throughout and impressive length on the finish.			
Domaine Jean Chartron Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru Clos du Cailleret	Code:B1433112	6-bottles	£295
A strikingly direct and pure-style Puligny with floral notes and pristine citrus fruits. Good tension and focus with a snappy, mineral palate and a distinct salinity on the persistent, lengthy finish.			
Domaine Jean Chartron Batard Montrachet Grand Cru	Code:B1618012	6-bottles	£875
Quite reticent at first, this powerful, brooding white opened up to show notes of freshly baked bread and sweet ripe fruits on the palate. Muscular and mineral with beautiful balance, it will undoubtedly reveal more with age.			

DOMAINE DUBREUIL-FONTAINE

First established in 1879, Domaine Dubreuil Fontaine is today run by 5th generation, Christine Dubreuil. The property is in the pretty village of Pernand Vergelesses and has a number of excellent vineyards including Clos Berthet, a 1.5 hectare walled vineyard which is the only Premier Cru Monopole in the area.

Domaine Dubreuil Fontaine Pernand Vergelesses 1er Cru Clos Berthet Monopole	Code:C1596012	12-bottles	£250
There's a striking minerality on this elegant white combined with creamy, toasty oak. It has great overall balance with open fruit along with ample richness and intensity.			

Domaine Dubreuil Fontaine Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru	Code:B1596112	6-bottles	£300
A notably spicy, toasty oak nose leads to ripe orchard fruit, steely and mineral flavours. There's great drive and penetration but it's also sleek and refined. Very focused and precise.			

WHITE BURGUNDIES

This selection of white Burgundies stood out for their combination of value for money and outstanding quality. All of them display the ripe, concentrated fruit typical of this low yielding vintage and also an attractive freshness with lovely balance.



	Laroze Drouhin Bourgogne Blanc	Code:C1861512	12-bottles	£120
This is crisp and discreet rather than rich or creamy with fresh peachy fruit and a touch of lychee. Very persistent with good overall balance and lovely cleansing acidity. Excellent early drinking.				
	Domaine Edmond Cornu & Fils Chorey les Beaune Blanc	Code:C1884812	12-bottles	£165
A very attractive nose of white flowers and exotic fruit is joined by a hint of mineral on the palate. This was already highly enjoyable back in November and will be delicious for early drinking.				
	Domaine Edmond Cornu & Fils Ladoix Blanc	Code:C1884912	12-bottles	£195
The Cornu family settled in the town of Ladoix in 1870 and established the vineyards in 1875. Only a handful of barrels of this white rarity are made, from vineyards just around the corner from Corton Charlemagne.				
	Domaine Bouzereau Gruere St Aubin 1er Cru Les Cortons	Code:C1859812	12-bottles	£265
Sisters, Marie-Anne and Marie-Laure, continue to produce excellent whites having taken over from their father, Hubert. Aromas of toast and flower blossom with gentle mealy notes. On the palate, it's taut and full of energy with a fine citric edge.				
	Domaine Bouzereau Gruere Meursault Les Tillets	Code:C0945112	12-bottles	£270
Tillets' elevation on the Côte and poor soil always give a wine of tension and minerality. It's still quite tightly coiled but with plenty of snap and great cut and vivacity. Long and racy with its usual delicious minerality.				

DOMAINE BACHELET MONNOT

Domaine Bachelet Monnot Maranges 1er Cru La Fussiere	Code:C0993612	12-bottles	£165
The reds here always take time to preserve the freshness and fruit within the wine, but we still managed to taste the Maranges which was just out of malolactic fermentation. Lots of energy and mineral character with a crisp, crunchy fruit palate.			

Domaine Bachelet Monnot Bourgogne Blanc	Code:C1593212	12-bottles	£140
This wine comes from vineyards around 30 feet outside of Puligny Montrachet itself. The brothers lavish the same care and attention on this wine as their grand crus and everything is hand-picked and highly labour intensive. As a result, this punches way above its humble Bourgogne Blanc status - creamy yet minerally and floral it has a piercing, focused freshness.			

Domaine Bachelet Monnot Maranges Blanc 1er Cru La Fussiere	Code:C1882012	12-bottles	£195
A delicate floral nose with excellent focus and beautiful concentration owing to extremely low yields. With lots of minerality and freshness on the finish, this is a truly impressive 2012.			

Domaine Bachelet Monnot Puligny Montrachet	Code:C1050712	12-bottles	£295
This has a really bright, vivacious nose with vibrant citrus fruits and a touch of oatmeal. There's a lovely succulence to it with its rounded, creamy texture and a marvellously fine, long finish. Lots of finesse.			

Domaine Bachelet Monnot Batard Montrachet Grand Cru	Code:B1593312	6-bottles	£775
A very complex wine with several layers of flavour. Still quite reticent and brooding at the moment but it already shows glimpses of brilliance. Creamy brioche and spice are supported by a wrap of mineral acidity. One for the cellar.			

DOMAINE ANTOINE JOBARD

Formerly known as Francois Jobard, the estate changed to his son Antoine in 2008. The domaine has been in the same family since 1860 and Antoine is the 5th generation to take over the reins. He only makes white wines and Meursault accounts for 95% of his overall production. The domaine is renowned for its elegant, mineral and complex wines, that age for many years.



Domaine Antoine Jobard Bourgogne Blanc	Code:C0979412	12-bottles	£185
A delicate honeysuckle perfume with background mealy notes. There's good grip and volume on the palate for a Bourgogne Blanc.			

Domaine Antoine Jobard Meursault En le Barre	Code:B0941212	6-bottles	£195
There's much more tension and focus compared to the Bourgogne Blanc but still with those attractive floral and honeyed notes. A very approachable style with Jobard's characteristic finesse.			

RED BURGUNDIES

“There are some who regard the potential of the 2012 reds as superior to anything recent, and that includes 2010, 2009, 2005 and others... So we have very little wine – in some cases where there was the worst of the hail damage, only half a crop – but what remains shows deep colour, plenty of backbone, no shortage of tannin (but sophisticated tannins), very good acidity and concentrated, profound, rich fruit. The aromas in the growers’ cellars are intoxicating.”

Domaine Chofflet-Valdenaire Givry 1er Cru Clos de Choue Code:C1884112 12-bottles **£170**
The Clos de Choué vineyard is a 6ha south-facing amphitheatre with some very old vines. This has a lovely perfume of ripe raspberry and wild cherry fruit. Intense fruits on the palate and good precision. A very good buy.



Domaine Jean Jacques Girard Pernand Vergelesses 1er Cru Fichots Code:C1875812 12-bottles **£180**
This village just around the corner from Corton produces some very elegant reds. This is no exception with exceptionally pure fruit, mineral nuances and an overall feeling of finesse.



Domaine Jean Jacques Girard Savigny Les Beaune 1er Cru Les Lavieres Code:C1875912 12-bottles **£195**
Jean Jacques’ family has been growing grapes in Savigny since 1529, so it’s no surprise that he knows this village like the back of his hand. This was the standout wine for us among his Savignys, showing lovely ripe open fruit supported by fine oak and balanced tannins.



Domaine Edmond Cornu & Fils Aloxe Corton Vieilles Vignes Code:C1884612 12-bottles **£240**
This comes from a parcel of old vines, some of which were planted in 1942 and the most recent in 1971. It’s an excellent example of Aloxe Corton with delicious, lively, bright fruit and attractive freshness.



Domaine Louis Boillot Gevrey Chambertin Code:C1902012 12-bottles **£265**
An extremely fresh and perfumed Gevrey Chambertin with very well defined dark cherry fruit. It has a wonderful purity to it with pristine, vibrant fruits and a delicious, long finish.



Domaine Philippe Cheron Chambolle Musigny Les Quarante Ouvrees Code:B1884312 6-bottles **£175**
This comes from several different parcels in Chambolle comprising around 1.5 hectares. A very attractive perfume with a classic Burgundian Pinot Noir scent. It’s surprisingly big for a Chambolle on the palate with lively, crunchy and expansive fruit.



Domaine Henri Gouges Nuits St Georges 1er Cru Clos des Porrets Code:B1025312 6-bottles **£195**
Gouges is one of the grand old domaines of Nuits St Georges and for many they define the style of this village. From a single vineyard , this is as complex, brooding and powerful as ever.



Domaine Louis Boillot Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Champonnet Code:B1036612 6-bottles **£250**
This is very well defined with dark cherry fruit and pure Pinot Noir fruit expression. Pristine and fresh, this wine proves that this rarely-seen 1er cru vineyard is able to produce outstanding Gevrey Chambertin.



Domaine Edmond Cornu & Fils Corton Bressandes Grand Cru Code:B1884712 6-bottles **£270**
Introvert in style at the moment but still fresh and fragrant with a sweet, ripe fruit core. Succulent fruit on the palate is balanced by fine oak and mineral tones. Powerful with layers of flavours but also tremendous elegance.



Domaine Henri Gouges Nuits St Georges 1er Cru Les Vaucrains Code:B0924312 6-bottles **£285**
Gouges is one of the most sought after names in Burgundy and Les Vaucrains, one of the finest sites in Nuits St Georges. Consequently, this wine is always much in demand. This is Pinot Noir at its best but sadly only available in very limited quantities.

MAISON ROCHE DE BELLENE

This is the relatively new project of Nicolas Potel, son of the late Gerard Potel who managed Domaine de la Pousse d’Or until his death in 1997. Nicolas went on to set up Maison Nicolas Potel, which he left in 2009 to establish Maison Roche de Bellene. Nicolas is considered among the most talented winemakers in Burgundy and is the name behind Averys’ label Burgundies.

Maison Roche de Bellene Côtes de Nuits Villages Code:C1593512 12-bottles **£130**
Nicolas compared his wines to those of 2009 owing to their concentrated, rich fruit. This is highly fragrant with an abundance of vibrant, crunchy red fruits on the palate. Delicious for early drinking.

Maison Roche de Bellene Vosné Romanée Code:B1881912 6-bottles **£165**
An attractive perfume with pretty red berry fruits and a touch of spice. Plush blackcurrant fruit on the palate is supported by fine oak and a luxurious, long finish. Still very tight with plenty more to give.

Maison Roche de Bellene Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Lavaux St Jacques Code:B1052012 6-bottles **£240**
As in 2011, this was our favourite among Nicolas’ 1er Crus. Tightly focused and precise, it’s taut and mineral but with plenty of sweet, ripe fruit underneath. A very cool and direct style, this needs time to show its full potential.

REMOISSENET PERE ET FILS

Our old friend Bernard Repolt, with Pierre Rovani, former Burgundy editor at Robert Parker’s The Wine Advocate, and the brilliant Claudine Jobard, have transformed the quality at this famous old house. Remoissenet now deserves at least as much attention for its young wines as for the famous old vintages in the cellars.



Remoissenet Père et Fils Meursault 1er Cru Genevrieres Code:B0923112 6-bottles **£265**
An elegant, floral fragrance with a fine mineral edge. On the palate, there’s mouth-watering freshness with delicate minerality and a highly citric finish

Remoissenet Père et Fils Beaune 1er Cru Marconnets Code:C1031212 12-bottles **£290**
Dense and ripe with a rich red cherry fragrance. Fresh and sappy with a fine, silky tannin texture and powerful long length. It’s the ripe fruit that comes to the fore initially with minerality on the finish.

Remoissenet Père et Fils Nuits St Georges Code:B1881512 6-bottles **£160**
This is ripe and refined and almost Vosné-Romanée-esque with its silky richness and profound complexity. Very succulent with generous fruit and spice and a finish that goes on forever.

Remoissenet Père et Fils Chambolle Musigny 1er Cru Aux Echanges Code:B1881612 6-bottles **£250**
Fragrant and full with a lovely perfume of bright red berry fruits. There’s a striking purity to it with sweet red berries and very fine silky tannins. Still quite tight and reined in, this is one for the cellar

Remoissenet Père et Fils Chambertin Clos de Beze Grand Cru Code:B1881812 6-bottles **£690**
Clos de Beze neighbours Le Chambertin and is one of Burgundy’s all-time great vineyards. This is very classic in style – complex, rich and with that perfect balance of Burgundian power and elegance. Dark fruit and spice with plenty of backbone and even a hint of liquorice towards the finish.

DOMAINE FRANCOIS BUFFET

Young winemaker, Marc-Olivier Buffet, has revitalised this old domaine in the heart of Volnay. The family have been growing vines here since the 17th century but since Marc-Olivier took over it has become very much a name to watch. They reported a 70% crop loss in 2012 and consequently, allocations are very small but quality is excellent.



Domaine Francois Buffet Volnay Code:C1593812 12-bottles **£230**

This is much riper than the 2011 and also displays a beautiful freshness. Extremely silky in its texture with very pure, pristine fruits on the palate and an impressively persistent finish.

Domaine Francois Buffet Volnay 1er Cru Champans Code:B1902112 6-bottles **£180**

A very fragrant nose with a lovely perfume of sweet, juicy raspberries. The palate offers more of those sweet berry fruits with a silken, tender mouthfeel and glorious lifted character.

Domaine Francois Buffet Pommard 1er Cru Les Rugiens Code:B1050612 6-bottles **£230**

A fantastic scent of red fruits soars from the glass and layers of flavour develop on the palate. Long, aromatic and poised with very fine tannins, this shows real class.

DOMAINE BERTAGNA

Claude Bertagna created Domaine Bertagna in the 1950s but it was bought by the Günter Reh family, owners of the Mosel's famous Reichsgraf von Kesselstatt, in 1982. Located just a few hundred metres from Château Clos de Vougeot and overlooking vines from the Vougeot appellation, it benefits from a perfect setting. It has some very impressive holdings including their famous Grand Crus of Clos Vougeot, Clos St Denis, Chambertin, Corton and Corton-Charlemagne.

This domaine was a new discovery for us and we're very excited to offer these wines for the first time this year.

Domaine Bertagna Vougeot 1er Cru Clos de la Perrière Monopole Code:B1885012 6-bottles **£250**

"There can be few better-placed vineyards than Perrière "The Burgundy Report. This Monopole is bordered to the west by Clos de Vougeot. It's a sleek and stylish red with lots of intense, lively raspberry fruit along with mineral notes and spice. Precise and complex, the quality and style hints of its famous neighbour.

Domaine Bertagna Clos St Denis Grand Cru Code:B1885112 6-bottles **£450**

Clos St Denis is located between Clos de la Roche and Clos des Lambrays in Morey. This was still very reined in and restrained with a wonderful silky profile. High-toned, delicate red fruits and spice with finely spun tannin.

DOMAINE HUDELOT BAILLET

Domaine Hudelot-Baillet is one of the most exciting estates on our list. Winemaker, Dominique le Guen married into the estate and is not from a wine background. With the friendship and guidance of winemaking legends such as Christophe Roumier and Frederic Mugnier, Dominique has gone from a standing start to becoming one of Chambolle's fastest-rising stars.

Domaine Hudelot-Baillet Chambolle Musigny Code:C0947412 12-bottles **£295**

Superbly open and fragrant at this stage, I'm sure this will shut down for a bit after bottling. Intensely perfumed and floral. The palate has crystalline purity of fruit, a silky texture and is almost heady with scent. This is text book Chambolle.

Domaine Hudelot-Baillet Chambolle Musigny 1er Cru Les Charmes Code:B1051112 6-bottles **£210**

Brilliantly aromatic young wine, this is ripe and musky with some exotic spice characters. Ripe and sweet on the palate, this is held together by a fine line of acidity and fine spun tannin. The finish is expansive and long.

DOMAINE LOUIS BOILLOT

Louis Boillot is descended from the Volnay family of Boillots but in 2002 chose to leave his father's domaine and made his first vintage in Chambolle-Musigny at the cellars he shares with his partner, Ghislaine Barthod. The two both share the same team in the vineyards but the wines are vinified separately. And while Ghislaine Barthod's wines are so sought after that we sell out in days (we have a small allocation this year – contact us for more details), Louis' wines fly slightly under the radar. We can't see it staying that way for long.

Domaine Louis Boillot Côtes du Nuits Villages Code:C1433612 12-bottles **£180**

We were really impressed with this Pinot Noir with plump cherry fruit aromas and sour cherry acidity on the palate. Lots of juicy, mouth-watering fruits and a very approachable style

Domaine Louis Boillot Gevrey Chambertin Code:C1902012 12-bottles **£265**

An extremely fresh and perfumed Gevrey Chambertin with very well defined dark cherry fruit. It has a wonderful purity to it with pristine, vibrant fruits and a delicious, long finish..

Domaine Louis Boillot Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Champonnet Code:B1036612 6-bottles **£250**

This is more mineral and less fruit-driven than the Villages wine with a classic Gevrey Chambertin spine. This rarely-seen 1er cru vineyard is a great example of what Gevrey Chambertin can produce.

GEVREY CHAMBERTIN

Gevrey Chambertin is the largest of all the wine villages in the Côte d’Or and boasts an impressive 9 different Grand Crus. This is a selection from three of our favourite winemakers in Gevrey that we have chosen for their style, quality and character.

First is Laroze de Drouhin, run by Caroline Drouhin, daughter of Philippe from Domaine Drouhin-Laroze. Working with the guidance of her father, out of the Domaine Drouhin-Laroze cellars, Caroline purchases grapes from top vineyard sites and crafts wines of purity and elegance. We also have a selection from her father Philippe at Domaine Drouhin-Laroze who owns some of the finest vineyards in the Côte d’Or with almost half of his vineyard holdings boasting Grand Cru status. Last but by no means least comes Domaine Rossignol Trapet. Brothers, David and Nicolas Rossignol, make wines which are quietly confident and assured, speaking softly yet eloquently. This is a property on fine form again in 2012 with the wines showing excellent concentration and purity of fruit.

LAROZE DE DROUHIN

Laroze de Drouhin Bourgogne Rouge Pinot Noir	Code:C0979812	12-bottles	£120
This is a serious, savoury-style Bourgogne – not surprising when you learn that most of the fruit comes from Morey St Denis and around Gevrey Chambertin. A classic Côte de Nuits nose with ripe raspberry and crunchy blackberry fruit.			
Laroze de Drouhin Charmes Chambertin Grand Cru	Code:B1059912	6-bottles	£360
Delicate floral and spicy aromas with precise, ripe fruit on the palate and a wonderful purity that lasts right through to the finish.			
Laroze de Drouhin Mazoyères Chambertin Grand Cru	Code:B1433712	6-bottles	£360
Much more masculine and more classic Gevrey Chambertin in style with mineral and spice fragrance. A firm backbone with fine minerality and rich black fruit.			

DOMAINE DROUHIN LAROZE

Domaine Drouhin Laroze Gevrey Chambertin	Code:C1044412	12-bottles	£280
Intense red fruit and smoky aromas with a lively strawberry and cream palate. Finely balanced with good density, length and texture.			
Domaine Drouhin Laroze Bonnes Mares Grand Cru	Code:B1036212	6-bottles	£390
Almost black in colour and although still quite closed on the nose, there’s powerful black fruit behind. Muscular and profound.

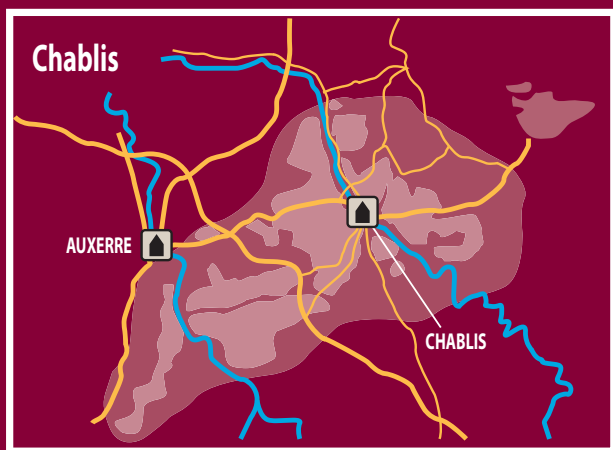
