SAMUEL BILLAUD

Samuel Billaud was winemaker at his family winery, Domaine Billaud-Simon, before he struck out on his own in 2009. He’s rapidly gained a reputation as one of the finest producers in Chablis with each vintage building on the last. Samuel describes 2020 as a classic vintage akin to 2012, 2014 and 2017, and the wines certainly live up to those benchmark years. Highlights include the Vaillons 1^{er} Cru from 70-year-old vines that “shows real sparkle even at this early stage” (Vinous.com) and the great value Grands Terroirs from plots in Les Pargues, Bas de Chapolot and Les Carts.

DOMAINE DES MALANDES

Lyne Marchive (née Tremblay) took over her family domaine in 1973 and passed on the running of her business in 2018 to her children, Richard (also of Domaine Richard Rottiers in Moulin-a-Vent) and Amandine. This domaine is a long-standing favourite with Averys customers and you’ll be delighted to hear that the 2020 vintage was another success. As ever, the wines combine power and richness with textbook Chablis minerality and precision.

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DOMAINE HERESZTYN-MAZZINI

Domaine Heresztyn has been around since the 1930s but was re-born Domaine Heresztyn-Mazzini in 2012 when Florence Heresztyn took over with her husband, Simon Mazzini, a highly regarded winemaker from Champagne. Florence explained that the very dry, warm summer meant there was less juice in the berries, leading to a loss of 50-55% in volume. On the bright side, what is available is incredibly concentrated and absolutely delicious!

From a single vineyard of 40-year-old vines in Champ Franc in the south of Gevrey, this certainly punches above its Bourgogne classification. 100% destemmed and aged in older barrels, it’s full of sweet raspberry and cherry fruit with lovely freshness.

A blend from three different vineyards, including a plot of 65-year-old vines, this is rich and concentrated with dark fruit, whilst 50% whole bunch fermentation gives freshness and grip.

From two vineyards in the south of Gevrey, this is fresh and structured with rich, creamy cherry fruit and a full finish.

From two vineyards in the north of the village where the vines are 90 and 102 years old. It’s richer and more solid in style than Les Jouis with dark, perfumed forest fruit on the nose. Fresh and intense with a very long, structured finish.

50% whole bunch and 25-30% new oak. A juicy, dark berry fruit nose leads into a creamy palate with savoury oak and nice freshness.

From a vineyard with a cool micro-climate which proved invaluable in the heat of 2020. Sweet, ripe fruit on the nose with nice density and smooth tannin.

On the Route de Grand Cru, below Mazis Chambertin, this is considered the finest of the Gevrey 1 ^{er} Crus. Very fresh and elegant with fragrant red fruits on the nose, creamy oak and a delicious savoury element.

Les Champonnets is quite a high vineyard, close to the Grand Crus and this is one of their most structured and age-worthy Gevreys. It has succulent berry fruit on the nose with impressive structure and freshness.			

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DOMAINE HUDELLOT-BAILLET

Dominique Le Guen took over from his father-in-law, Joel Hudelot, in 2002 and the quality here is superb. Dominique describes 2020 as a standout vintage but the heat and wind meant the berries lost a lot of juice close to harvest and consequently, volumes are around 30% down.

LAROZE DE DROUHIN

Laroze de Drouhin is managed by Caroline Drouhin, daughter of Philippe, and the winemaking is done at the Drouhin Laroze cellars.

From plots between Gevrey Chambertain and Brochon. A fragrant honeysuckle and white blossom nose – smells like summer in a glass! Very silky with a fresh finish.

From plots on the lower slopes around Morey-Saint-Denis and Chambolle Musigny. A gorgeous nose of creamy, smoky fruit and sweet spices. It's rich yet elegant, energetic and light on its feet with a lovely freshness.

Lovely Pinot aromas with crisp berry fruit. A bright, richly-fruited palate with crisp acidity keeping it fresh.			

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DOMAINE BERTAGNA

The vineyards of Domaine Bertagna once belonged to the Cistercian monks, famous for founding Clos de Vougeot in the 13th century. The winery is today owned by the Reh family who have an exceptional collection of vineyards, with plots in five Grand Crus and seven Premier Crus, including the monopole Clos de la Perrière.

Les Beaux Monts is well located adjacent to Echezeaux Grand Cru. The nose is brimming with dark, perfumed forest fruits. On the palate, it's crisp, fresh and crunchy with nice intensity building on the finish.

There's only half as much of this as there was last year. It's dark and luscious with sweet forest fruit and smart, spicy oak. Impressive concentration and length.

A lovely sweet and spicy nose. Great intensity and richness on the palate yet also very fresh and elegant with a long, persistent finish.

Cellar Master Denis Rozat



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First established in 1879, Dubreuil-Fontaine in the hillside village of Pernand-Vergelesses is today run by 5th generation Christine Dubreuil. The family own and live in Clos Berthet, Pernand-Vergelesses' only monopole, and the red and white from these vineyards always shine. 2020 was the earliest ever harvest at Dubreuil Fontaine with all the picking finished by 29th August! Christine likens the wines to the 2014s, both stylistically and qualitatively.

This white had already been bottled and was showing beautifully with lots of juicy citrus fruit and a bright, floral finish.

The property's 1.5 hectare monopole mainly produces the white 1 ^{er} Cru but they also grow a small amount of Pinot Noir. Beautifully fresh and fragrant, it has a perfumed nose of pretty red berry fruit. Silky and fresh on the palate with a lovely delicacy.

A very perfumed Chardonnay with floral citrus fruit on the nose. Really weighty and rich with creamy, ripe fruit and a silky texture.

Originally founded in 1529 by Jean Girard, this is one of the oldest domaines in Savigny. It's thriving under the direction of Jean-Jacques, who makes some of the best wines in the village.

Clos du Roi is a 1 ^{er} Cru at the northern end of Beaune. Fresh and elegant with juicy, sweet fruit and a long, crisp cherry finish.			



Domaine David Duband

When David Duband took over his family domaine in 1991, all the wine was being sold to négociants. David began bottling his own estate wines instead and has since expanded the domaine's vineyard holdings, which now include five Grand Crus and seven Premier Crus. One of Burgundy's rising stars, he's built a formidable reputation in a relatively short space of time and impressively has listings in 16 out of 25 of France's Michelin-star restaurants. This is the first time we've offered David's wines en primeur and we're sure they'll be well received.

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Domaine François Buffet

The Buffet family has been making wine in Burgundy since 1692. Marc-Olivier Buffet took over from his father in 2005 and has taken the wines to another level. He has seven hectares of vineyards including prime holdings in Volnay and Pommard.

Clos de la Rougeotte is a monopole to the north-east of the village and is the first plot to be harvested. An inviting rich nose with bright, juicy fruit and a silky sheen.

From vines over 100 years old and 1/3 whole bunch fermented, this has a darker fruit profile than the Pommard with hints of violets and spice. Rich and rounded with fleshy dark fruit.			

Domaine Joseph Voillot

Joseph Voillot retired in 1995 and the estate is now looked after by his son-in-law, Jean-Pierre Charlot (who had worked alongside Joseph for 15 years), one of our favourite winemakers in the Côte d'Or. He has a huge respect for Burgundy traditions and allows the terroir to do the talking. He was joined at the family domaine in 2016 by his nephew, Etienne Chaix, and together they make wines of wonderful purity, delicacy and grace.

Jean-Pierre's Pommard comes from old vines averaging over 50 years of age and makes for a powerful, rich village wine. Soft and creamy with dark fruit, rounded tannin and a juicy, fresh finish.

The vines average 60 years of age in this plot with some planted as early as 1934. Super-rich, grippy and firm with incredible concentration.

Epenots and Rugiens are the two best-known 1 ^{er} Crus in Pommard and many believe they should be elevated to Grand Crus. Coming from 50+ years old vines, this has super concentration and great freshness. Very pretty.

An elegant style with a delicate, reserved nose. Fresh and structured with great fruit behind and firm tannin on the long, fresh finish.

Les Rugiens is a 1 ^{er} Cru just south of Pommard and Jean-Pierre's vines here date back to 1959. Gorgeous, dark, rich blackberry fruit with lovely freshness.			

Domaine Jean Monnier

The Monnier family established their estate in Meursault in 1720 and today own around 16 hectares between Beaune and Puligny Montrachet. Jean Claude and his son Nicolas Monnier currently run the domaine, with Nicolas looking after the winemaking. In our mind, these whites offer some of the best value in all of Burgundy.

It's worth noting that 2021 was a particularly challenging year at this domaine and volumes are down by as much as 70%. Nicolas informed us that there will be no Genevrières at all next year, so if you're a fan of these wines, be sure to stock up this year!

Domaine Jean Monnier & Fil Côte d'Or Chardonnay

From vineyards just outside Meursault, this is a lovely, fresh Chardonnay with citrus and a touch of oatmeal.

Domaine Jean Monnier et Fils Beaune 1^{er} Cru 'Montrevenots' Blanc

Montrevenots is a 1^{er} Cru vineyard at the southern limits of Beaune. The 2020 offers incredible price versus quality.

Domaine Jean Monnier & Fils Meursault

Coming from old vines, this is rich and rounded with creamy, ripe fruit balanced by lovely acidity. Fresh and focused.

Domaine Jean Monnier & Fils Puligny Montrachet

There's impressive concentration here with a creamy, rich nose and balanced new oak. It has great drive and energy with fleshy, ripe fruit and fresh acidity.

Domaine Jean Monnier & Fils Meursault-Charmes 1^{er} Cru

Les Charmes is a highly regarded 1^{er} Cru that rivals many Grand Crus. Ripe and fresh with floral notes, creamy new oak and fresh, crisp lemon acidity. It finishes long with hints of citrus and new oak.

A beautiful mineral and floral nose with ripe, concentrated fruit on the palate. Full and ripe yet lots of freshness and precision too.

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Domaine Alain Chavy

The Chavy family have a long history in Puligny and the wines used to be bottled under the label Domaine Gerard Chavy et Fils. In 2003, the two brothers split the vineyards to create their own domaines and Alain owns around seven hectares. These are classically styled, very elegant whites.

This domaine has been in the same family since 1860 and Antoine is the 5th generation to take over the reins. Antonine has decided in this vintage to blend all his Meursault lieux dits together, rather than bottling single vineyard wines, to create a thoroughbred village Meursault.
